- Be registered for a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 18 credits
- Exhibit peer leadership.
- Be familiar with the ASB Constitution and Corban Community Life Walkthrough
- Demonstrate an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ
- Have a passion for being the voice of others
- Area representatives must plan to reside in the area that they are representing for the duration of their term.

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

The ASB Senator must:

- Meet bi-weekly and other meetings as needed with the ASB Executive Vice President
- Gather input and understand the pulse of their area
- Fairly represent voices and opinions that may not be their own
- Advocate for the needs the student population that they represent

TIME COMMITMENT:

The ASB Senator must:

- Be able to meet for one hour bi-weekly.
- Devote time to understanding and representing the student body's voice
- Expect to work up to six hours per month
